

American Sign Language Minor

The minor in sign language will involve a developmental sequence of 15 credit hours in sign language courses and 3 credit hours in Deaf Culture, for a total of 18 credits. Students outside of the ASL/English Interpreting Program will have an opportunity to strengthen an additional skill which will make them more employable and acceptable for graduate programs. Students may wish to major in an area of interest and want to work with the deaf/hard of hearing population in that area. Students must maintain a C or better to progress to the next level of ASL and Deaf Culture courses.

This checklist is based on the current Academic Catalog and is subject to change. Students should meet with their academic advisor each semester and use Degree Works to monitor their individual progress toward completion of the minor.
