HEERF III (American Rescue Plan) Reporting

Bloomsburg University has signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement form for the American Rescue Plan to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Bloomsburg University received \$10,668,504 to be provided to students in the form of Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

As of 12/31/2021, \$5,347,660 has been distributed to eligible students equaling 50.13% of our allocation. Additional ARP funding will be held for Spring 2022 to award block grants to eligible students.

An estimated 7,788 students were potentially eligible for these funds. As of 12/31/2021, 7,788 students have received funds.

Eligibility was determined based on reviewing EFCs as determined on the 21-22 FAFSA. As defined in regulation, priority was given to the highest need students. Additional tiers of eligibility were also established as outlined below.

Additional ARP funds were awarded on a case-by-case basis as emergency applications were reviewed. Priority was given to Pell eligible applicants during the emergency application review process.
