#### **RETURNING STUDENT MOVE-IN**

Sat., January 25<sup>th</sup> 9:00AM – 8:00PM Sun., January 26<sup>th</sup> 9:00AM – 8:00PM

If you are required to attend orientation, you need to be checked in before 12:30 Sunday Jan. 26th. Orientation check is from 12:30 until 1, with orientation sessions running from 1 until 4.

# WHAT <u>NOT</u> TO BRING

For the safety of yourself and others, the following items are prohibited in our residence halls:

- × Alcohol and alcohol bottles (including empty bottles) regardless of purpose\*\*
- × Illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia
- × Candles, used or decorative
- × Incense and incense burners
- × Cooking appliances with an open/exposed heating element/surface including, but not limited to, toaster, toaster oven, hot plate, electric grill
- × Space heaters
- × Fireworks and other explosives

- × Pets other than fish in a 10-gallon or less tank
- Weapons and weapon replicas including, but not limited to, firearms, tasers/stun guns, nonfolding knives with a blade over 3" in length, switchblades, double-edged blades, crossbows/bows and arrows
- × Halogen bulbs
- × Hoverboards, self-balancing/electric scooters, anything containing a gasoline motor
- Anything that is not legal to own according to local/state/federal laws

\*\* Alcoholic beverages and containers are permitted for residents residing ONLY on the fourth floor of Sycamore Hall.

All residents and guests must adhere to the alcoholic beverage policy that is outlined in the Guide to Campus Living.





#### CONSIDER PERSONAL PROPERTY INSURANCE

Personal property insurance protects your belongings against damage or loss. Commonwealth University partners with National Students Services, Inc. (NSSI) to provide coverage plans designed specifically for students living in university residence halls featuring low deductibles and affordable premiums. The University is not responsible for personal property damaged due to loss, fire, theft, flooding, or other reasons.



#### USE APPROVED PRODUCTS WHEN DECORATING

Pictures, posters, lights, and other decorations may only be hung on walls/doors with Command™ products or push pins. Other products such as nails, screws, and other adhesive products are damaging, and their use may lead to damage charges. When using Command™ products, please ensure that you are hanging them correctly with the tabs exposed for proper removal when it is time to vacate the suite.



Commonwealth University - Mansfield partners with Apogee to provide internet service and support for our residential students living on campus. To make connecting to our residence hall internet service, you can set up your account and register devices prior to your campus arrival. Please follow the following steps to set up your account:

- 1) Begin set-up by going to the Apogee ResNet welcome page
- 2) Click "Sign In" and use your University email address and password (your Single Sign-On)
- 3) Click "My Devices"
- 4) Set up your own Wi-Fi password by clicking in the box and changing the password preset
  - a. Select a password that you will remember! You can also change this in the future
- 5) Add your devices
  - a. Choose your device from the drop-down menu and name it
  - b. Enter MAC Address
    - Turn off Private MAC Address for Apple iOS and watchOS devices
  - c. Click "Add Device"
