Login & Menu

Login to CU Succeed & look for the three-line menu icon at the top left of your screen.

From the drop down menu, choose

Courses.

Browse Network tab by Courses

If available, "Peer Tutoring" will show up as part of your Net work tab for each course. Click on the Peer Tutoring link & then the "Schedule Appointment" link err

Choose a Peer Tutor

Next, peer tutors who support your course will display. Choose a tutor by clicking their name.

Schedule an Appointment

From your peer tutor's page, click "Schedule Appointment". Follow the prompts to confirm.



Schedule writing tutoring and Peer Research Consultant appointments by conducting a service search for "Writing" or "PRC" from the My Success Network menu link. Login to CU Succeed (Steps 1 & 2 above), choose My Success Network from the menu, and search.
