We play music from movies, video games, Broadway shoes, as well as traditional orchestra music and music by living composers!

The Orchestra typically performs three to four times a year. In the fall semester, in addition to a more traditional-styled concert, we perform our annual Young Persons' Concert for area elementary school students. We have about 1,000 students attending the concert. It's a little more laid back than your typical concert with audience interaction, a laid-back atmosphere, a wider variety of music, and just a fun atmosphere overall. In the spring semester, we are performing with guest artists in March. We are constantly pushing ourselves to become better musicians, while still maintaining an atmosphere of support and encouragement. We also have a little bit of fun playing some great music. We are always looking for ways to engage with the community. We're always building a sense of community.
