

Fall/Spring Title IV Withdrawal

Any student who is receiving Federal financial aid and is contemplating withdrawal from the university should contact the Financial Aid Office or the Student Billing Office to determine how the Federal refund policy governing financial aid will affect them.

If a student withdraws on or before completing 60 percent of the semester, the student is only entitled to financial aid based on the percentage of time that was completed.

For Fall 2024 I, completion of 60% of the semester would be Saturday, October 26, 2024.

For Fall 2024 II, completion of 60% of the semester would be Monday, September 23, 2024.

For Fall 2024 III, completion of 60% of the semester would be Friday, November 15, 2024.

For Spring 2025 I, completion of 60% of the semester would be Saturday, April 5, 2025.

For Spring 2025 II, completion of 60% of the semester would be Monday, February 24, 2025.

For Spring 2025 III, completion of 60% of the semester would be Thursday, April 24, 2025.

If a student withdraws from Commonwealth University, a portion of the Title IV financial aid funds the student received may need to be **returned** to the federal government.

The student should note that PHEAA State Grant may still require a reduction of the Pennsylvania Grant if a student's charges are reduced as a result of a withdrawal from one or more classes or a complete withdrawal from Commonwealth University.

If a student who has borrowed from the Direct Loan program withdraws from Commonwealth University, the student must repay these loans according to the terms of the promissory note.
