## TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT BETWEEN COMMONWEALTH UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA and LUZERNE COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this <u>3</u> day of <u>anvar</u>, 2025, between Commonwealth University of Pennsylvania of the State System of Higher Education (including Bloomsburg, Lock Haven, and Mansfield campuses) and Luzerne County Community College.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual promises hereinafter expressed and intending to be legally bound hereby, the Parties agree as follows:

## A.e INTRODUCTIONe

Commonwealth University of Pennsylvania and Luzerne CountyCommunity College (hereinafter referred to as "Commonwealth University and "LCCC") agree to establish this Transfer Scholarship Agreement. Students who apply for transfer admission to and graduate from LCCC are granted admission to Commonwealth University with at least full junior standing in Commonwealth University's parallel major (i.e, criminal justice-to-criminal justice), with an offer for a renewable transfer scholarship based on the students' academic performance while enrolled at LCCC and at Commonwealth University. The following criteria for admission and scholarship consideration must be met:

- 1.e Apply for transfer admission to Commonwealth University after thee completion of a minimum of 30 credits at LCCC.e
- 2.e Graduate with an Associate Degree in any LCCC major.e
- 3.e Submit all final LCCC transcripts after graduation for consideration of e Transfer Scholarship eligibility at Commonwealth University.e
- 4.e Any Associate Degree graduate of LCCC will qualify for a transfere scholarship to Commonwealth University if the graduate has earned ae minimum 2.0 grade point average overall at LCCC.e
- 5.e Commonwealth University will award 4 tiers of transfer scholarships toe LCCC graduates according to the students' academic performance at thee community college, and the students' residency choice when enrolling ate Commonwealth University. Tier 1 (3.50 GPA or above at LCCC) wille award \$4,500 annually if living in residence halls and \$3000 off-campus,e Tier 2 (3.0 3.49 GPA at LCCC) will award \$3,500 annually if living ine residence halls and \$2,500 off-campus, Tier 3 (2.50 2.99 GPA ate LCCC) will award \$2,500 annually if living in residence halls and \$2000e off-campus, and Tier 4 (2.0 2.49 GPA at LCCC) will award \$1,500e annually if living in residence halls and \$1,000 off-campus.

- 6.e Transfer scholarship recipients must remain enrolled full-time for at leaste 12 credits per academic semester and must maintain an overall GPA of 2.0e at Commonwealth University to remain eligible for the scholarship.e
- 7.e The scholarship is renewable for up to seven (7) consecutive semesterse (fall and spring) or to the completion of the CU degree, whichever comese first.e

The purposes of this agreement are:

- 1.e To establish a seamless transfer admissions partnership agreement thate involves the participating community college and 4-year Bachelor degreee granting institutions.e
- 2.e To cooperatively provide a program that recognizes the value of an earnede Associate Degree from LCCC, and the opportunity for graduates toe seamlessly continue towards a Bachelor Degree credential ate Commonwealth University, with the potential for scholarship money toe allow for an affordable student experience.e
- 3.e To enable qualified graduates of LCCC to build upon their education ande training by earning a baccalaureate degree in a seamless educationale partnership.e
- 4.e To enable Commonwealth University to attract a more diverse populatione of students in transfer who have already demonstrated academic success.e
- 5.e To enable community college graduates to obtain a quality education at ae low cost, and, in doing so, provide the commonwealth with additionale qualified graduates.e
- 6.e To ensure recognition of the continuity of academic progress ande transferability of credits between two-year and four-year programs.e

## **B. PROCEDURES**

LCCC agrees to publicize this Transfer Scholarship Agreement to prospective students in its admissions literature and as part of regular student recruitment, and inform qualified, matriculating students of the opportunity for admission to Commonwealth University under the terms of this agreement.

LCCC students must enroll within one semester of graduation and cannot attend another four-year institution after graduating from LCCC.

LCCC students must complete the Commonwealth University transfer application and provide all transcripts by June 1, and pay the deposit fee by July 1, if enrolling for the following fall semester. Students must complete the transfer application and provide all transcripts by December 15, and pay the deposit fee by January 1, if enrolling for the following spring semester. The following items are the responsibility of students participating in the Transfer Scholarship program:

- 1.e Complete an earned Associate Degree at LCCC with a minimum overalle grade point average of 2.00 on a 4-point scale.e
- 2.e At the time of application, provide transcripts of all college courses takene up to and including the previous semester.e
- 3.e Upon receiving the Associate Degree from LCCC, provide completee LCCC transcripts to Commonwealth University.e
- 4.e LCCC students must complete the Commonwealth University transfere application by May 15 if enrolling for the following fall semester or bye December 1 if enrolling for the following spring semester ate Commonwealth University. Admission under this agreement will bee contingent upon completing items 1 to 3, above, and receiving ane Associate Degree from LCCC.e
- 5. Pay the required advanced deposit to hold a seat for the initiale semester of admittance.e
- 6.e Pay Commonwealth University's tuition and fees for those semesters ine which they are registered for courses at Commonwealth University.e
- 7.e The last 60 semester hours of study toward graduation must be completede at Commonwealth University. Students enrolled at Commonwealthe University shall comply with its academic policies and requirements.e Specific academic policies and degree requirements in effect for thee Bachelor Degree, as awarded by the University, will be such as exist at thee time of student enrollment in the program.e
- 8.e Complete four semesters of study on the Commonwealth Universitye campuses in Bloomsburg, Lock Haven, or Mansfield, and follow thee recommended course sequence for LCCC Transfer Students.e

## **C. CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT**

- 1.e A Transfer Coordinator shall be identified at LCCC ande Commonwealth University who will assist all students in transitione regarding the transfer application process, housing requirements ate Commonwealth University, referral to an appropriate academice advisor, and consideration for a transfer scholarship award.e
- 2.e The term of this agreement shall be five years commencing when alle applicable signatures are obtained. The first cohort of eligible students ine transfer will be part of the Fall 2025 transfer class to Commonwealthe University. Scholarships are reviewed annually and are subject to change.e
- 3.e Either institution may withdraw from the agreement upon writtene notification of the other, with exception to commitments already in effecte for students who have applied to Commonwealth University. Suche commitments will be honored. In the event of a substantial breach, such as, a lack of response to requests for information and or adequate participation, either party may terminate this agreement.e

- 4.e The relationship of the parties to this contract shall not be construed toe constitute a partnership, joint venture, or any other relationship, other thane that of independent contractors.e
- 5.e The parties agree to continue their respective policies of e nondiscrimination based on Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 ine regard to sex, age, race, color, creed, national origin, Title IX of thee Education Amendments of 1972 and other applicable laws, as well as thee provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act.e
- 6.e Neither of the parties shall assume any liabilities as a result of thise agreement. As to liability to each other, death to persons, or damages toe property, the parties do not waive any defense as a result of entering intoe this contract. This provision shall not be construed to limit Commonwealthe University of Pennsylvania's rights, claims or defenses, which arise as ae matter of law pursuant to any provisions of this contract. This provisione shall not be construed to limit the sovereign immunity of thee Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or of the Pennsylvania State System of e Higher Education or Commonwealth University.e
- 7.e This agreement represents the entire understanding between the parties.e This agreement can be modified only in writing with the same formality ase the original agreement.e
- 8.e This agreement shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with thee laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.e
- 9.e Nothing in this agreement shall interfere with the Parties' ability to complye with applicable law including, but not limited to Act 76 of 2019 and Act 69e of 2024 with regards to transfer of credits or guaranteed admission.e
